1944-46	Works as a carpenter and joiner
1946-49	Serves in the Royal Air Force
1949-52	Studies at St Martin's School of Art with Leon Kossoff and Frank Auerbach
1952-55	Studies at Royal College of Art with Peter Blake and Richard Smith
1955	Receives Knapping Foundation prize and Rome prize. Lives and works in Rome where he meets, Joslyn Morton, who is studying under Marino Marini at the Brera in Milan. They live together at Cefalù in Sicily
1956	Marries Joslyn Morton in Venice
1958	Returns to London and begins teaching at St Martin's School of Art, London which he continues until 1963
1960	Receives the Gulbenkian Foundation prize
1962	First one-man exhibition opens at the Marlborough Gallery, London. He continues to exhibit with the Marlborough Gallery in New York and Rome until 1977.
1962-63	Visiting lecturer at the Slade School of Art, London; and at King's College, Newcastle upon Tyne
1963	One-man show at Walker Art Gallery, Liverpool
1964	Exhibits at the British Pavilion at the XXXII Venice Biennale
