**Joseph Beuys: *Boxkampf für die Direkte Demokratie*
7 July - 11 August 2017, Waddington Custot, Mayfair, London**

Performance artist Joseph Beuys believed it was possible to transform society through the creativity of every individual. In this show at Waddington Custot, an artwork originally staged by the German artist in 1972 is resurrected. The piece is a boxing match between the artist and sculptor Abraham David Christian, using screened archival footage of Beuys.
